2. OFL *Make It Fair* Campaign

- *Make It Fair* is a campaign of the Ontario Federation of Labour (OFL) to mobilize labour unions to fight for labour law reform, in solidarity with the *Fight for \$15 and Fairness* campaign.
- The current minimum wage is \$11.40 per hour, but the government plans to increase the minimum wage to \$14 per hour on January 1, 2018, and \$15 per hour on January 1, 2019, followed by annual increases at the rate of inflation.
- D10 will send a delegate to be part of OFL Members lobbying MPP Rick Nicholls about the *Make It Fair* campaign on Thursday, June 8, 2016.

3. Lobby Day at Queen's Park Follow-Up

- Follow-up meetings have been held with each of our provincial representatives (Bob Bailey of Sarnia-Lambton, Monte McNaughton of Lambton-Kent-Middlesex, and Rick Nicholls of Chatham-Kent-Essex) who agreed to raise the issue of workplace violence in the education sector with the Premier, Minister of Education, and Minister of Labour.

4. Supporting Students and Communities Engagement Session

- District 10 was represented at the local Ontario Government-sponsored engagement session to provide input on strengthening rural education.
- The session was to share ideas about how the province can provide students with quality education programming and make the best use of school space and public resources.
