## OCCASIONAL TEACHERS' REPORT

### 1.0 Occasional Teacher List

- 1.1 There is a link on the District 10 website ([www.osstfd10.ca](http://www.osstfd10.ca)) to the Occasional Teachers' Posting for the Long-Term Occasional list. Applications to be considered for the list close on Friday, September 13, 2013.

### 2.0 Retired Teachers

- 2.1 Teachers who retired in June or earlier in 2013 were automatically included on the Occasional Teachers' list. Four teachers took advantage of this option. However, future retirees will have to apply for a position on the Roster.
- 2.2 For seniority purposes, retired teachers will have a start date beginning with their inclusion on the Occasional Teacher Roster. This will mean, effectively, that retirees will not be eligible for Long-Term Occasional work except in extremely rare circumstances.

### 3.0 Occasional Teacher Work 2012-2013

- 3.1 As of September 1, 2013 there are 229 names on the Occasional Teacher list. Of these, 20 are retired Lambton Kent District School Board teachers. This is down from the 26 on the list on September 1, 2012. Retirees accounted for 0.025% of total supply days worked.
- 3.2 In 2011-2012, 11 307 supply days (long term and occasional) were used; in 2012-2013 the number rose to 17 240 or an increase of 52%. This increase is in great measure due to the eradication of the cafeteria supervisors and for this we thank Barb and Hugh for their efforts on behalf of the Occasional Teachers Branch.
